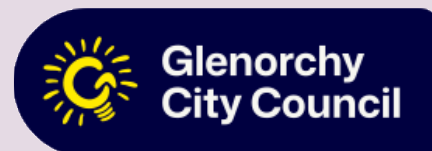


Terms and Conditions

Tolosa Park



1. Bookings can be made 12 months in advance.

Payment of the hire fee must be paid in full at the time the booking is taken.

Payment may be made in person or by telephone with a credit card on (03) 6216 6800. Bookings will not be confirmed until payment is received.

2. To receive a refund, cancellation must be made to the Council at least two weeks prior to the original booking.

Bookings may be transferred to another date at any time. A refund is not available if the booking was transferred within 2 weeks prior to the original booking.

Unreasonable weather will not justify a transfer or refund.

3. Huts must be occupied within 30 minutes of the stated time of arrival

4. Glenorchy City Council takes advance bookings in good faith that the park will be available to the public on the booking date.

However the Council reserves the right, and the user acknowledges that the bookings may be cancelled or moved to another date should the park be required for other purposes.

5. The user nominated on this agreement shall be responsible for the behaviour of all persons at the function.

Parents must always supervise children's behaviour and safety. A Park Ranger is always on duty, and their instructions must be obeyed.

The Ranger is in radio contact with the Police who will be called if any person refuses to obey instructions.

6. Vehicles must observe speed limits and park where indicated.

Driving tuition is not permitted in the reserve. Animals are not permitted within the reserve.

No persons are permitted inside the perimeter fence of the actual water storage area.

7. The user agrees to pay any reasonable costs involved in the repair of Council equipment damaged during the period of hire.

All rubbish, litter etc. need to be placed in the bins provided. Huts that have left an unreasonable amount of rubbish after hire may be charged for the clean-up. Articles that cannot be recycled may be put in the bin marked 'Litter Only'.

8. Business operations, vendor vans, marquees, merry-go-rounds, jumping castles, trains, pony rides and gender reveal that create excess mess are not permitted within the reserve because of the potential danger to the users of the park.

However, an application may be made in writing to the Property Services Manager to seek approval for the use of any such items for events held in the Tolosa Park Reserve.

9. Approval for the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages only and other commercial activities associated with events held at Tolosa Park will be considered by the General Manager following written application by the organisers

That approval will only be granted on an annual basis. The General Manager reserves the right to permit any or all these activities.

10. Large numbers of people (over 150) classify as a minor event and notification to the Property Manager in writing is required.

Public Liability insurance will be required for bookings exceeding 150 persons.

If required, the policy shall be for 20 million dollars (\$20,000,000) and must be in the joint names of the Principal and Hirer.

The Glenorchy City Council, its servants and agents, accept no liability of whatever description for any injury, death, damage or theft, which may occur on this facility, however caused.

11. Council encourages you to have an enjoyable time at this venue but please ensure that your behaviour does not impact on the enjoyment of other park users.

12. Read this Agreement carefully including the day, date and hut details.

Any discrepancies must be notified to the Glenorchy City Council on (03) 6216 6800 immediately otherwise Council will not be held responsible.

13. The hirer must ensure that any employees, agents, volunteers, and contractors who may interact with children under 18:

- a) comply with child safety laws including reporting incidents and keeping current all necessary working with children checks;
- b) implement the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations (available at: childsafe.humanrights.gov.au/national-principles);
- c) assess the child safety risks and make a plan that will prevent harm or abuse to Children and share this with people at you event;

With reasonable notice, the Council may conduct a review of the Licensor's compliance.
